



CBA - Bring Your Own Device Technology Initiative

In consideration of CBA’s commitment to prepare young men for both the collegiate and professional world, the school maintains a “Bring Your Own Device” (BYOD) policy for students. Technology has become a seamless part of education in the 21st century and the preferred approach, as it is on the collegiate level as well, is to allow students to choose a device that works best for them. There will, however, be minimum requirements for the student devices to ensure consistency of capability throughout all classes. The device must fulfill the following requirements: (1) run a modern, supported operating system that is actively updated by the manufacturer; (2) run a modern, fully featured web browser such as Google Chrome, Firefox, Internet Explorer 11, Microsoft Edge, or Safari; (3) run a productivity suite and note taking software such as Google Apps or Microsoft Office; (4) be Wi-Fi enabled; (5) have battery life to last through the school day; (6) power up in less than 90 seconds; (7) run personal firewall/antivirus/anti-malware software that is enabled (most modern computers have software tools built-in).
