Dear CBA Class of 2023 and Family,

Welcome back to what I know will be an amazing junior year! I hope that each of you has had a great summer filled with fun and relaxation and will soon be ready to return to an exciting and challenging junior year. There are several notable events in the first months of the school year including:

- September 24, 2021 Junior Tie Ceremony and Luncheon (more information below)
- October 8, 2021 Big Brother Social (Class of 2023 and Class of 2025)
- October 13, 2021 PSAT Day for all sophomores and juniors
- October 26, 2021 Junior Parent Guidance Night Henderson Theater 6:30pm.

## Other things to note as we return to school:

- Students are expected to follow Covid-19 protocols including not attending school if ill. Parents of students who have been exposed to Covid-19 or who are exhibiting symptoms should contact me as soon as possible.
- Juniors should arrive at school no later than 8:20 on Wednesday, September 8, 2021. Dismissal will be at 12:30pm. Parents are asked to wait to pick up students until 12:45pm to ease congestion on those first days of school. Juniors will not attend school on September 7, 2021.
- The school building will be open daily by 7:15 am. Students arriving early should report to the library, cafeteria or if necessary the designated overflow areas. The library and if necessary designated overflow areas will be open until 5pm each day.
- The Pegasus Yearbook is an award winning student publication that chronicles the many events of the school year. Yearbook orders are due by November 5, 2021. The cost is \$35 if purchased by November 5, 2021. Yearbooks ordered after that will be \$45. No orders will be accepted after January 28, 2022. To avoid waste we will order only enough yearbooks to cover the orders so if you would like a yearbook please be sure to order one.
- 2020-2021 Yearbooks will be distributed in homeroom in September to those who ordered them.

Junior year is certainly a notable time here at Christian Brothers Academy as your sons are no longer viewed as boys, but are considered true men of the Academy. This is an accomplishment to be proud of and celebrated, since it marks a commitment to Christian Brothers Academy and changes your son's status into that of an upperclassman. He is now expected to be a leader and example to those classes behind him. As you may already be aware, we hold the Signum Fidei Junior Tie Ceremony to commemorate this rite of passage. Signum Fidei is the motto of the Brothers of the Christian Schools and means "sign of faith." This ceremony is a sign of faith from the administration and faculty that these young men, after making it to this crucial year, will continue and graduate from CBA in May of 2023 as "Academy Men."



As such, we would like to invite you to attend the **Signum Fidei Junior Tie Ceremony** on **Friday**, **September 24, 2021** at 11:00 AM in the Varsity Gym during which juniors will receive their Class Tie. This tie, in Academy colors and designed uniquely for the Class of 2023, can be worn only by them from that day forward and will hopefully become a cherished keepsake. A luncheon reception will follow this event. There are no additional charges for the juniors, for the ties or the lunch and it is expected that they will all attend. Parents/guardians who wish to attend this ceremony are most welcome. Those wishing to stay for the luncheon must reserve a space in advance. The cost of the luncheon is \$25 per guest with a limit of two guests per student.
