Dear Member of the Class of 2024 and Family,

I am very excited to announce that the Senior Lounge will make its long awaited return this year. The lounge will be open from periods 3 through 7. Seniors are reminded that the lounge is a privilege and rules regarding the lounge should be followed at all times.

As part of the planning please note that the Senior Parent School and College Counseling Night is on Thursday, September 7, 2023 at 6:30PM in Henderson Theater. Parents should mark their calendars for this very important event in which information about the college planning process will be shared.

Other things to note as we return to school:

- Included in this mailing is our 2023-2024 Calendar Handbook.
- Seniors should arrive at school no later than 8:15AM on Tuesday, September 5, 2023. Seniors will begin the day in Henderson Theater. Dismissal will be at 12:30PM. Seniors will not attend school on September 6th or 7th. The first day of classes will be on Friday, September 8, 2023 and will begin with the Mass of the Holy Spirit.
- The Class of 2024 photo will be taken on Tuesday, September 5, 2023. Students not in • compliance with the dress code will not be permitted to be in the class photo.
- Members of the Class of 2024 who have not had senior portraits done must schedule an • appointment to do so. Normandy Studios will be available on September 5th and 6th to photograph seniors who were unable to have portraits done last spring. If a senior has not been photographed a previous year's photo will be used if possible. If that is not feasible the senior will not be included in the 2023-2024 yearbook. - The school building will be open daily at 7:30AM. Students arriving early should report to ۲ the Library or the Dining Hall. The Library will remain open until 5:00PM each day.
- 2022-2023 Yearbooks will be distributed in homeroom in September to those who ordered them. Seniors do not need to order a 2023-2024 yearbook as all seniors receive a personalized copy of the yearbook.
- Seniors may be extended the privilege of early dismissal (after Period 6) only on days that their scheduled classes end before 2:30pm. Seniors must sign out in the main office prior to



leaving the building and may not leave until the start of Period 7. To participate once this privilege is granted each senior must return a senior early dismissal form signed by his parent or guardian. The form can be found on the 2024 Class Page.
