

Dear CBA Class of 2025 and Family,

Welcome back to what I know will be an amazing Junior year! I hope that each of you has had a great summer filled with fun and relaxation and will soon be ready to return to an exciting and challenging Junior year. There are several notable events in the first months of the school year including:

## Other things to note as we return to school:

- Included in this mailing is our 2023-2024 Calendar Handbook.
- Juniors should arrive at school no later than 8:15AM on **Wednesday**, **September 6**, **2023** and report directly to homeroom. The Junior Tie Ceremony will take place at 1:00PM.
- Juniors will not attend school on September 5 or on September 7, 2023. Friday, September 8, 2023 will be the first full day of classes and will begin with the Mass of the Holy Spirit.
- All Juniors will have their picture taken on Wednesday, September 6, 2023. Enclosed with this mailing is the Normandy Studio photo form. The photo form has a QR code which allows you to place your order online using a credit card. If you'd rather pay by check, please bring the completed form and check to school on the 6<sup>th</sup>. If you pay online, you do not need to bring the photo form to school on picture day. Any student in violation of the Dress Code & Grooming requirements as stated in the handbook will not have his picture taken. - The school building will be open daily at 7:30AM. Students arriving early should report to the Library or the Dining Hall. The Library will be open until 5:00PM each day.
- The Pegasus Yearbook is an award winning student publication that chronicles the many events of the school year. Yearbooks can be ordered online on the 2025 Class Page or by bringing cash or check (in an envelope with student's name) to the main office. Yearbook orders are due by November 10, 2023. The cost is \$50 if purchased by November 10, 2023. Yearbooks ordered after that will be \$60. No orders will be accepted after February 2, 2024. To avoid waste we will order only enough yearbooks to cover the orders so if you would like a yearbook please be sure to order one.
- 2022-2023 Yearbooks will be distributed in homeroom in September to those who ordered them.

Junior year is certainly a notable time here at Christian Brothers Academy as your sons are no longer viewed as boys, but are considered true men of the Academy. This is an accomplishment to be proud of and celebrated, since it marks a commitment to Christian Brothers Academy and changes your son's



status into that of an upperclassman. He is now expected to be a leader and example to those classes behind him. As mentioned in last month's email, we hold the Signum Fidei Junior Tie Ceremony to commemorate this rite of passage. Signum Fidei is the motto of the Brothers of the Christian Schools and means "sign of faith." This ceremony is a sign of faith from the administration and faculty that these young men, after making it to this crucial year, will continue and graduate from CBA in May of 2025 as "Academy Men." As such, we would like to invite you to attend the **Signum Fidei Junior Tie**Ceremony on Wednesday, September 6, 2023 at 1:00PM in the Varsity Gym during which Juniors will receive their class tie. This tie, in Academy colors and designed uniquely for the Class of 2025, can be worn only by them from that day forward and will hopefully become a cherished keepsake. A luncheon reception will follow this event. There are no additional charges for the Juniors, for the ties or the lunch and it is expected that they will all attend. Parents/guardians who wish to attend this ceremony are most welcome. Those wishing to stay for the luncheon must reserve a space in advance. The cost of the luncheon is \$30 per guest with a limit of two guests per student. For reservations by credit card please visit the 2025 Class Page by August 25, 2023 or you may return the enclosed form with your check made out to Christian Brothers Academy. No reservation will be accepted after August 25, 2023.

It is my hope that many of the Juniors have applied to serve as Big Brothers to the Class of 2027 as they make the transition to high school.
